Saturday, 9 am - 11 am September 13 – October 4 Cost: \$150 + \$20 Supply Fee		This class is designed for the beginner in mind and will cover the basic and intermediate levels of working with clay. Focus is on learning how to throw utilitarian forms on the pottery wheel and hand-building sculptural objects. During wheel throwing, the essential process of centering clay on the wheel, forming cylinders, bowls and plates by pulling walls, shaping and trimming will be demonstrated. Techniques of hand-building sculptural forms through pinch, coil and slab method will be learned. In addition, glaze and firing techniques for electric kiln and atmospheric kilns will be discussed. Opportunities for networking and visiting local artist studios and gallery openings as a group will be ongoing. Materials will be provided and research is encouraged on the culture and history of ceramics. Class fee includes 25 lbs of clay, tool kit and firing fees. Limit of 2 students per class due to equipment.
